

Welcome back to the New Term

It has been a mixed summer weather wise, with lots of activity in the shop. The tourists have done us proud, without them we would be dead in the water in the summer months while most of you are enjoying the great outdoors. We really appreciate their support, they have travelled from all over the place and we love to think of the stuff we sell them zooming all over the world.

This year as well as featuring panels in abundance our speciality has been the northern sky fabrics. Over the last year I have been amassing a good variety of bolts. So in May we unveiled them and discovered that we had in excess of 45 different fabrics. Then we were able to cut a fabulous Layer Cake with a great spread of fabrics all different - the tourists loved them. We made 2 sample quilts to show them off, from BPQ patterns, a lap quilt using Lori's Quilt pattern and a large Queen using Lightening pattern. You can see them in the shops or on FaceBook. The slight problem is that the more yardage we sell the stash of bolts diminish, and we may get below the magic 40 fabrics. I tell the customers that there is not another shop in the whole of North America that stocks as many Northern Sky fabrics as we do. I hope they don't find one and challenge us!

We also chose the most dramatic northern lights fabrics and made two different Sudoku bundles with sample quilts, such fun we have had in the shops. If you get inspired to get either the Sudoku bundle or the Layer Cake, do not delay else you may be disappointed.



The pop up shop had a new location this year, in our first year we were in the left end of the of the Seacans on the back row, then in our second year we moved to the right hand end next to the Bistro. I have to say I liked that

location as the bistro smells were delicious and tantalizing AND they delivered the burger and chips to the shop. Did I admit to buying burger and chips when I worked there? ©

This year we were super lucky to get a unit on the deck, right in the middle of the row, it is much more sociable, visible and in the thick of the action. I have found time to be in the pop-up once a week and it's lovely with music and generally busier, and nearer to the loos. I really enjoy it and it gives us an opportunity to access a different sort of visitor. They are greatly impressed by our Territory and what the Canadian North has to offer. Enough about the summer, let's welcome you back to our new term and new quilting. We have a good variety in our classes, as you will see. We have little change in the teaching staff, **Geana** is travelling quite a bit and has decided she will not have time to teach. Thank you Geana for your work in the past and some interesting quilts, and for introducing Bosal into our life in the Camden bag class.

On the counter side of the shop we have a new recruit, **Gwen Laxton**, great to have her join our team. We soon discovered that she has sewing skills that none of us have, with her machine embroidery she has created some fabulous stuff, which we hope to see more of.
